If you home-school your youth (kindergarten - 12th grade), don't miss out on the opportunity to use Youth Programs' Open Recreation. It's available Monday - Friday, from 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Our open recreation area consists of a wide variety of game equipment, including Wii, for your youth's enjoyment. Also available is a computer room with internet access, full size gymnasium, full size outdoor basketball court, snack bar and lots of other activities and amenities. Additionally, youth can be members of various clubs, such as the Keystone Club, Torch Club, Hispanic Heritage Club and more.

Eligibility: This program is open to all dependents, kindergarten - 12th grade, of active duty and retired military, DOD & NAF civilian employees, DOD contract employees and bonafide houseguests of eligible patrons.

All home-schooled users must be a current member of Youth Programs. Membership costs \$40 a year per youth. If you are a club member, just show your AF Services Card to receive a \$10 discount.

During home-school usage, parent(s) must provide complete supervision. The Youth Center is not age appropriate for children ages 5 years and under. Parents may opt to make hourly care reservations at the Child Development Center by calling 494-7028.

Youth members, ages 9 and up, may use the Youth Center without parental supervision during normal hours of operation, 2:30 - 7 p.m. This is a great meeting place to make new friends.
