

POOL RULES

- Patrons shall follow the directions of the lifeguards and refrain from distracting them while on station. Patron concerns shall be directed to the staff member at the front desk.
- Patrons shall evacuate the pool area and facility upon announcement of phase 2 lightning conditions and/or any other unsafe condition. Patrons must seek shelter in their vehicles during phase two lightning conditions; use of the shower/restroom area for shelter is not authorized.
- Lifeguards shall issue a 10-minute penalty to patrons who receive more than three warnings for their behavior. The patron shall remain off the pool deck during the penalty time. Patrons receiving more than two penalties in one day shall be asked to remain off the pool deck for the remainder of the day. Offensive, threatening or abusive behavior will not be tolerated. Offenders will be directed to leave the facility immediately.
- Food and beverages (other than water) are not authorized on the pool apron.
 Glass containers are strictly prohibited throughout the entire facility to include the locker rooms.
- Children not toilet-trained must wear snug-fitting plastic pants designed specifically for water play.
- Children aged 6 years or older are not authorized in the opposite gender locker room.
- Patrons shall shower before using the pool. Individuals displaying signs of a communicable infection, open sores or lesions shall be prohibited from entering the pool.
- No running, skipping, hopping etc. and no horseplay.
- Small toys that do not obstruct lifeguards line of sight to underwater areas are authorized when used in a safe manner. Hard toys such as footballs, basketballs etc. are not authorized due to injury potential when thrown.
- Personal Flotation Devices (PFD) must be type I, II or III U.S. Coast Guard approved. Water wings and inflatable toys are not authorized to be used as flotation devices. A parent/guardian must be within arm's reach of their child at all times when a PFD is used.
- Swim masks, fins and snorkels are not authorized.
- Patrons shall refrain from leaving valuable items in the restroom/change areas. Outdoor Recreation
 is not responsible for items lost, damaged or stolen.
- Non-DoD cardholder guests are the responsibility of the sponsor. Guests who do not abide by the rules will be directed to leave the facility immediately.
