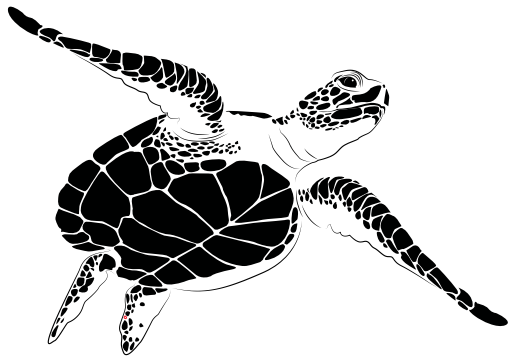

Sea turtles nest each year
from March through October on PSFB
beaches; all personnel, tenants, and
visitors on PSFB must follow the
requirements to protect
threatened/endangered species
& their habitat:

- It is against state/federal laws to touch/disturb nesting sea turtles, hatchlings or their nests.
- Avoid digging above the high tide line and destroying turtle eggs.
- Avoid using flashlights or flash photography while on the beach at night.
- Turn off outside lights when not in use, close blinds & shield indoor lights from shining onto the beach at night. Lights disorient adults and hatchlings and can prevent them from returning to the sea.
- Take your trash with you.
- Use designated dune crossovers. Do not trample dune vegetation.
- Do not build fires on the beach.
- Take beach equipment off the beach each day.
